

Call for Papers!

The Co-Editors-in-Chief of the Journal of Geriatric Emergency Medicine (JGEM) invite authors to submit **Original Research** manuscripts and **Clinical Case Reports** for consideration in this scholarly journal. The following describes JGEM's mission and guidelines for submission.

Mission

The mission of JGEM is to improve emergency health care for older adults by providing an open access, peer-reviewed, quality education and dissemination platform giving providers in all disciplines the evidence they need to enhance emergency care for older adults.

Submissions Needed

1. **Original Research** papers in the following disciplines as they relate to emergency care of older adults:

- Emergency Medicine
- Ethics
- Geriatrics
- Health and Medical Administration
- Medical Specialties
- Medicine and Health Sciences

Authors are invited to submit their **original research/clinical investigation** and articles using one of the following formats:

- Quality Improvement, Models of Care, or Program Dissemination
- Education and Training:
- Ethics
- Health Policy and Economics
- Global GEM

2. **Clinical Case Reports**

Prior to submission, authors must review JGEM's [Author Guidelines](#) for specific formatting requirements as well as other submission categories offered. All submitted articles will be reviewed on a blind review basis by two peer reviewers. The final decision regarding acceptance/revision/rejection will be based on the reviews received from the reviewers and at the sole discretion of the Co-Editors-in-Chief.
