- O1:25:27 Amy Stuck: @Tess, hospitals are often conflicted when it comes to avoiding admissions and providing alternatives to inpatient care. They may want this for their value-based contracts but not for all patients- since that's how they get paid. We work with a local PACE program (program for all inclusive care of the elderly) who are not connected to the hospital. They DO provide the safe alternative to admission.
